Protocol for PDP Forms not being returned on Time

PDP form not returned on Time at start of Rotation

- If PDP form is not returned within 4 weeks of the start of rotation a verbal warning is given to SpR to return PDP form within the next 2 weeks otherwise they may be subject to a GREEN form for Dr In Difficulty being submitted to Faculty of Radiologists and Radiation Oncologists with the possibility of this being discussed with Fellowship Advisory Committee (FAC) and possibly sanctioned.
- If PDP form is not returned within 6 weeks of the start of rotation then the SpR will be subject to a GREEN form being submitted to the Faculty of Radiologists and Radiation Oncologists with the possibility of this being discussed with Fellowship Advisory Committee (FAC) and possibly sanctioned.
- If PDP form not returned within 8 weeks of the start of rotation then the SpR will be subject to a YELLOW form being submitted to the Faculty of Radiologists and Radiation Oncologists with their case being discussed with Fellowship Advisory Committee (FAC) and possibly be sanctioned for same.

PDP form not returned on Time at end of Rotation

- If PDP form is not returned within the (locally) specified deadline date before date of end of rotation local SpR assessment then verbal warning given to SpR to return PDP form by the local assessment date otherwise they may be subject to a GREEN form for Dr In Difficulty being submitted to Faculty of Radiologists and Radiation Oncologists with the possibility of this being discussed with Fellowship Advisory Committee (FAC) and possibly sanctioned.
- If PDP form is not returned within 2 weeks of date of end of rotation local SpR assessment then the SpR
 will be subject to a GREEN form being submitted to the Faculty of Radiologists and Radiation
 Oncologists with the possibility of this being discussed with Fellowship Advisory Committee (FAC) and
 possibly sanctioned.
- If PDP form is not returned by the end of the rotation then the SpR will be subject to a YELLOW form being submitted to the Faculty of Radiologists and Radiation Oncologists with the possibility of this being discussed with Fellowship Advisory Committee (FAC) and possibly sanctioned.
