Summary of the curriculum rationale.	This is a revised curriculum to include all new advances in the field since the last version and to match all the requirements for the national, European and international standards to facilitate mutual recognition of training.
Purpose of the curriculum	The purpose of this curriculum is to define the process of training and the competencies needed for the award of a Certificate of Satisfactory Completion of training in Radiation Oncology.
Structure of the curriculum	This is a 5 full-time equivalent year accredited duration curriculum which includes at least 10 modular rotations across 3 accredited training centres (Cork / Galway / SLRON). It also includes some spiral component as some of the competencies with the advanced techniques are developed along several modules
Additional information	The current training program is partially linked to the Royal college of Radiologists in UK; our trainee has to sit joint exams with the Royal College of Radiologists UK.
